COOPER SANDERS

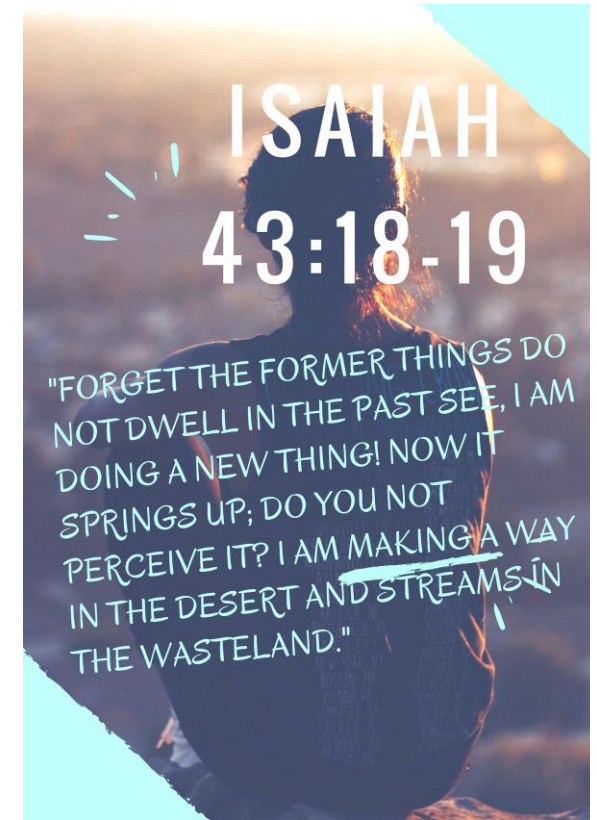
Meet Cooper! Cooper is in the 4th grade at Sanford-Fritch Elementary. He will be 10 this month!
