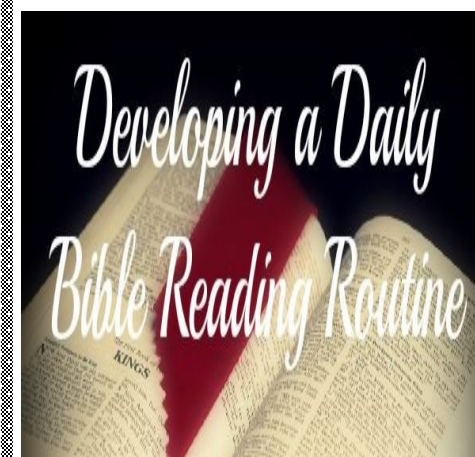

There is a table in the hall for these items.

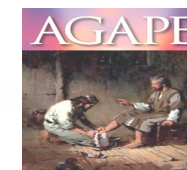
The High Plains Children's home "Change Cans" are due back TODAY.

Family Growing Time in His Word Activity: Memorizing a Bible verse a month to do as a family. Show your kids just how important it is to get into His word.

For 2nd—4th grade: 2 Corinthians God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

For Pre-K-1st grade:

Psalms 138:1 I will praise you, O Lord, with all my heart; before the "gods" I will sing your praise.
