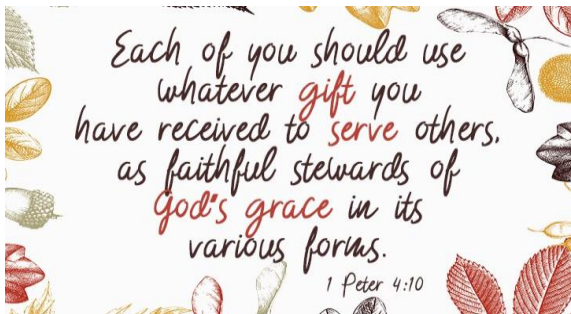

### TREVOR & AUBRIE WALLIN

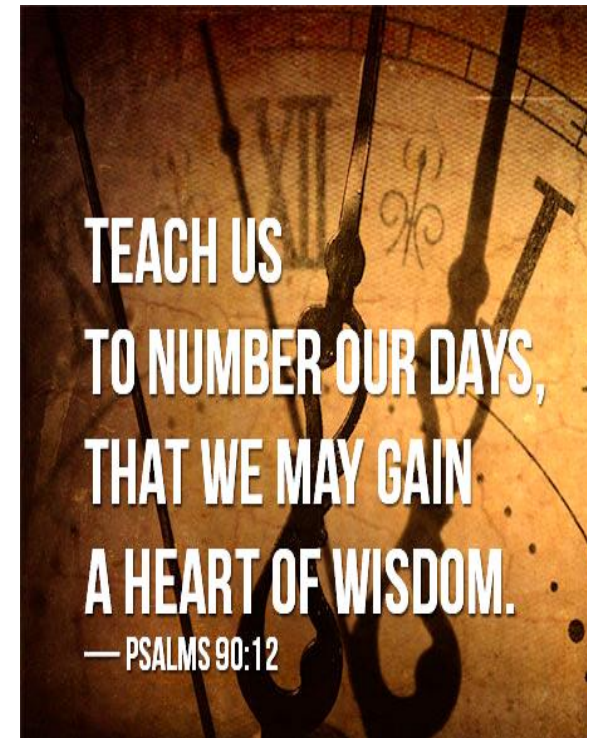
Meet our Youth Ministry family! Trevor and Aubrie came to us in February of this year from Placerville, CA.
