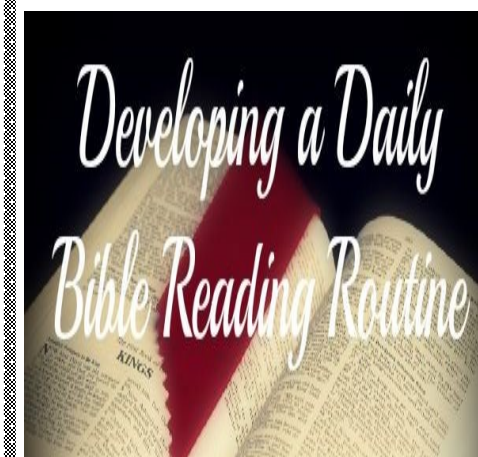

# Message from the Elders

## PREEMINENCE

Preeminence, means to be first, is a noun and it's meaning is older than the word "earth" in Genesis 1:1.

The practice of the word can be used for either good or bad. The meaning was understood in heaven, is found on earth and in the words of God and Jesus.

God and Jesus have the preeminence in heaven and Jesus has preeminence on earth and in His Kingdom. Matt. 28:1 And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth."

In heaven the angels, who have freedom of choice, submitted to preeminence and continue to do so as they serve God and Jesus out of reverence for who they are. Psalms 103:20.

Satan was one such angel whose dislike for God's preeminence soon consumed him and he began to assume some form of preeminence which was, is and will always be reserved for God. His assuming that which was not his, led him not to keep his established order and his destruction. 2 Peter 2:4-5. "For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into hell and committed them to pits of darkness, reserved for judgement...". NASV Jude 6 "And angels who did not keep their own domain, but abandoned their proper abode, He has kept in eternal bonds under darkness for the judgement of the great day." NASV

On earth preeminence was seen in the Garden of Eden. When tempted, Eve wanted to share in God's preeminence so she could be like (equal to) God. Genesis 2:5-6

The scriptures reveal that there is only one who is to have and can have the preeminence and that is Jesus. "And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence." Col. 1:18 NKJV. Preeminence is a divine role revealing the sovereignty (dominion) that Jesus has over His kingdom. A kingdom has four components. A king, a geographical location, laws and people to rule. Jesus is the King of His kingdom, the Church is His Kingdom, His New Covenant is His law and the saints of His body are His subjects. In this divine order, this can only happen when there is only one who has the "Preeminence": that is "to be first."

Just as was in heaven, in the Lord's kingdom there are those who want and at times demand the preeminence. 3 John 9 "I wrote to the church, but Diotrephes, who loves to have the preeminence among them, does not receive us. 10 Therefore, if I come, I will call to mind his deeds which he does, prating against us with malicious words. And not content with that, he himself does not receive the brethren, and forbids those who wish to, putting them out of the church. 11 Beloved, do not imitate what is evil, but what is good. He who does good is of God, but he who does evil has not seen God. 12 Demetrius has a good testimony from all, and from the truth itself. And we also bear witness, and you know that our testimony is true." NKJV. May we never sin in any way that usurps the preeminence of Jesus.

Let the saints of the kingdom remember, like the angels of heaven, that Jesus is King, Lord and Head of the body and we are His subjects and His redeemed. We are to revere Him as the "Preeminent One" and as such, we are to be obedient to the role each of us have in the church, as was in the first century church. Eph. 4:11-14 "And He gave some...as evangelists, and some as pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ; 13 until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ." Every member of the kingdom is to be a servant, so praise and honor the Preeminent One. John 12:25-26 "He who loves his life loses it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it to life eternal. 26 If anyone serves Me, he must follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also; if anyone serves Me the Father will honor him." NASV

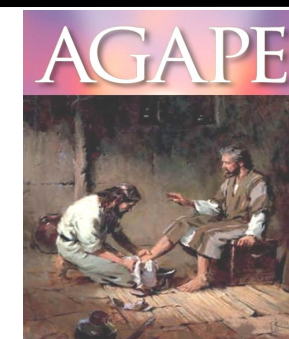
